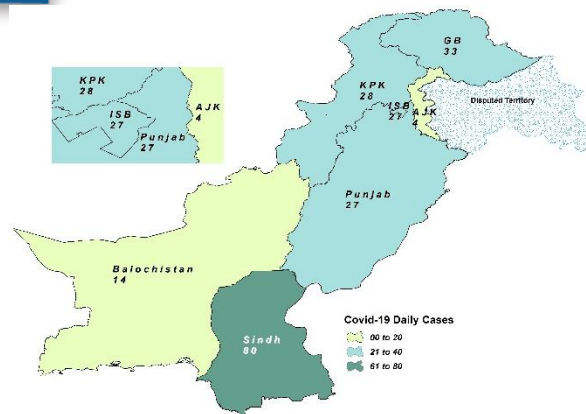

Executive Summary

Daily Incidence by Province

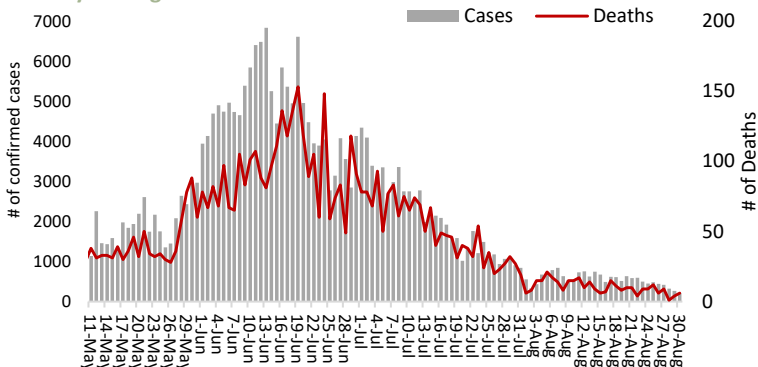
Pakistan reported **213** new cases of COVID-19 on **30 August 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **295,849** with **6,294** deaths (CFR: **2.12%**). Out of the total **8,873** currently active cases, **1,088** cases are hospitalized, out of which **604 (55.51%)** are in critical condition. **7,785** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **280,682 (94.89%)** have recovered and discharged.



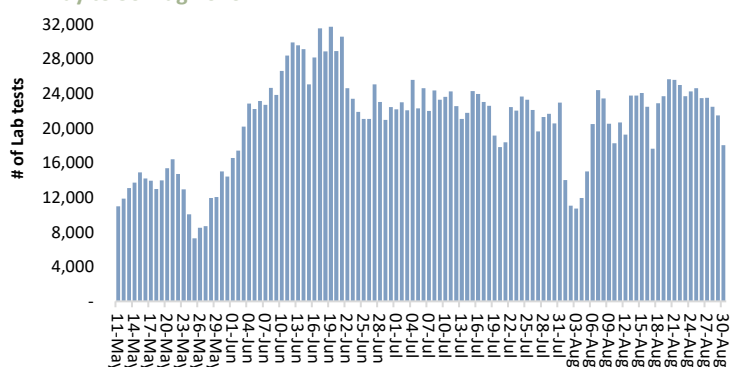
Daily Incidence/Mortality

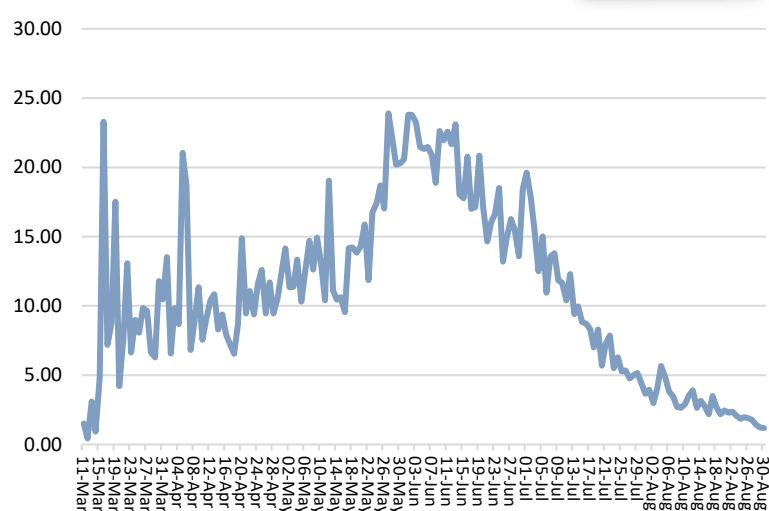

Meeting & Coordination

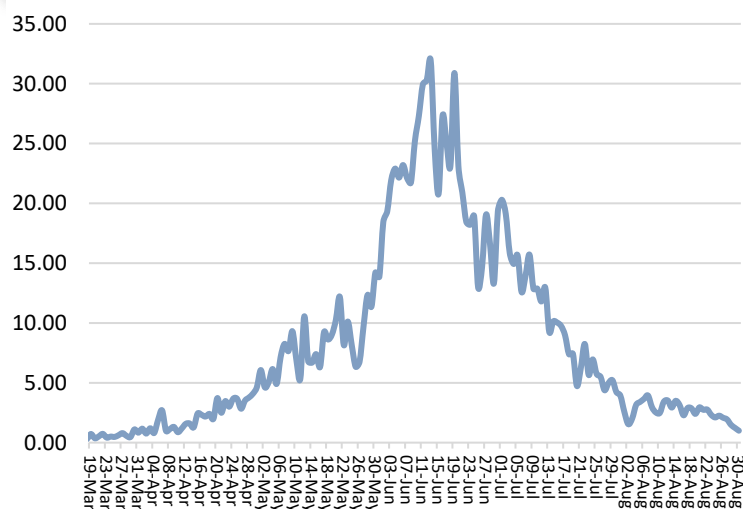
Today, 31st August 2020, an agreement was signed between WHO country office Pakistan and European Civil Protection & Humanitarian Aid Operations (ECHO) to finalizing the organizations support towards WHO's continuing COVID19 response. The main areas of support to be covered by the **2.5 million Euros** grant include Strengthening coordination at national and provincial levels; strengthening of COVID19 surveillance at points of entry, health facilities and sentinel sites, strengthening laboratory testing and quality assurance and supporting case management including infection prevention and control .

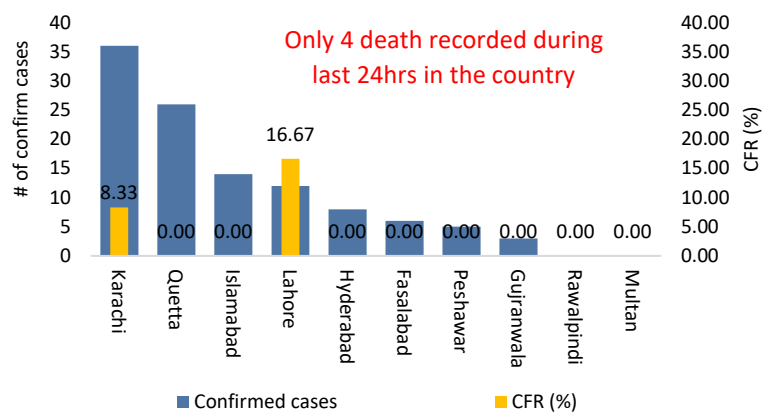

by Major Cities / Districts

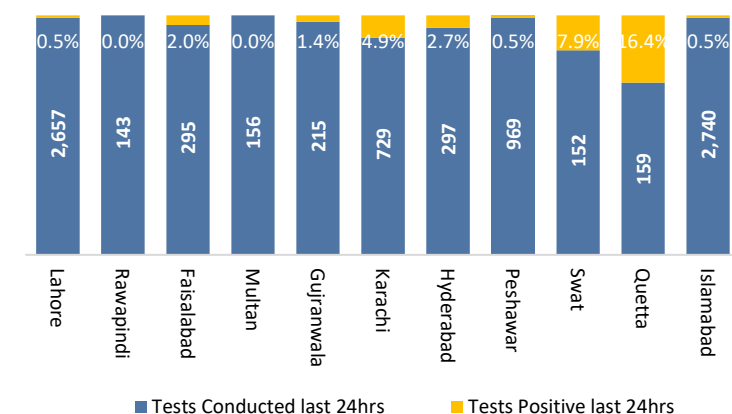

by Major Cities / Districts

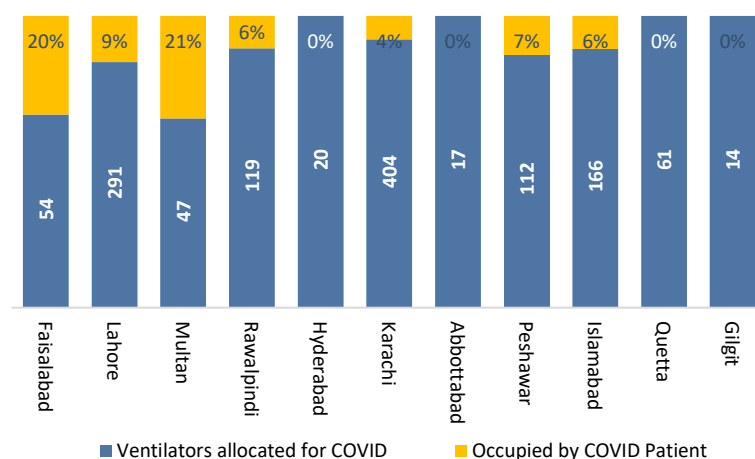
