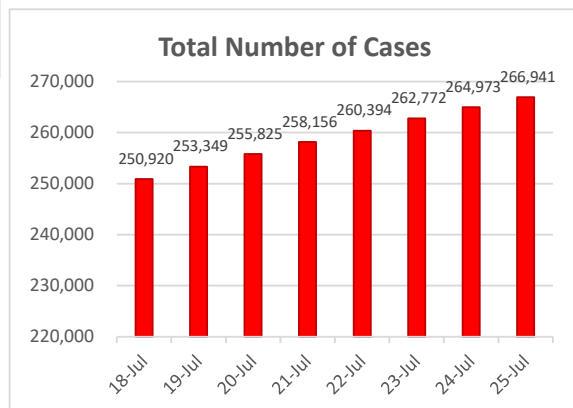
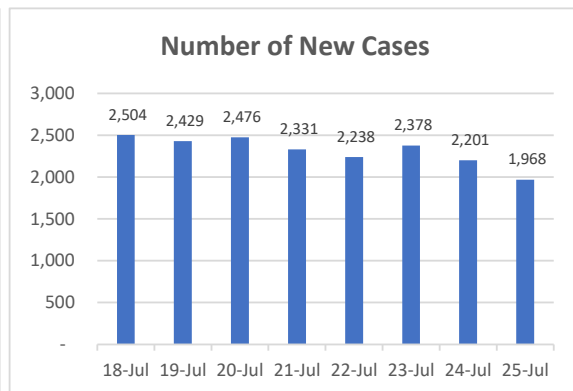

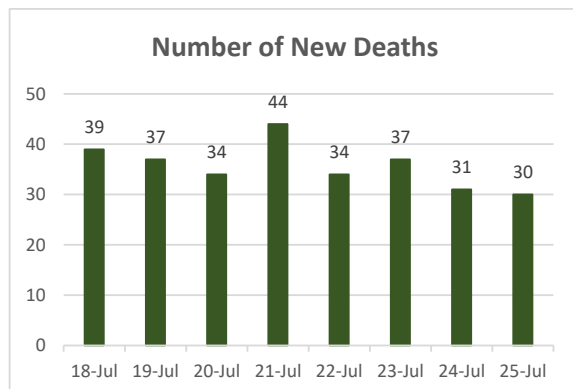
HIGHLIGHTS

- Cities with highest new infections were: Hufuf (208), Taif (195), Riyadh (126), Makkah (109), Hafr AlBatin (90), Al Mubarraz (86), Buraidah (77), Dammam (64), and Madinah (59).
