

# Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19)



## Situation Report No. 29 - Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 12 April 2020

### HIGHLIGHTS

- Total confirmed cases 4,462 on the 12th of April, 429 new cases.
- Out of the total, 761 recovered and were discharged and 7 new mortalities were recorded; there are 3,642 active cases, 65 in a critical condition.
- Distribution of newly reported cases: Riyadh (198), Makkah (103), Madinah (73), Jeddah (19), Dammam (10), Yanbu (7); in addition to cases in 6 other localities;
- More than 7,000 are currently quarantined, including nearly 2,000 of returning nationals who are in stable conditions.
- 5% of individuals in quarantine have been confirmed with COVID-19.
- Curfew extended across the nation until further notice.
- A baby delivered at a hospital in Madinah is the first case in Saudi Arabia to be born to a coronavirus-infected mother.
- Saudi FDA approves conducting an international clinical trial for COVID-19 in collaboration with WHO in 5 hospitals.
- Saudi CDC warns against the use of COVID-19 rapid tests for the diagnosis of COVID-19
- Saudi CDC releases second version of Guide to Health Requirements for Workers Housing for COVID-19 (see link below), including an assessment checklist.

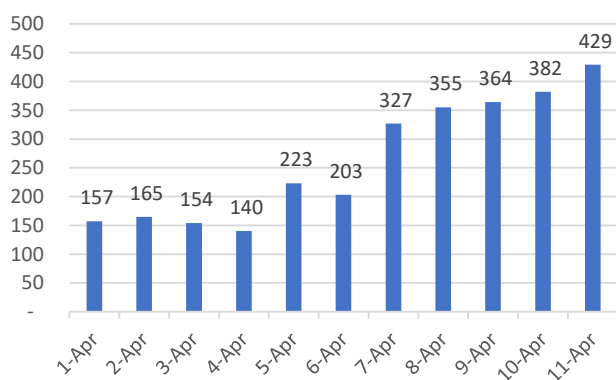

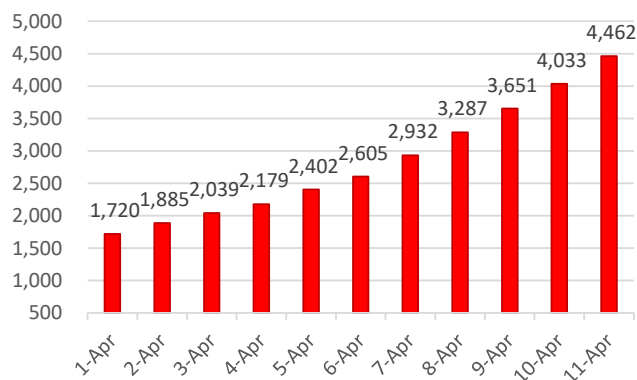
