## Situation Report No. 67 - Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 3 June 2020

### HIGHLIGHTS

- 2,171 new cases bringing total cases to 91,182. Of the new cases, 45% were Saudis.
- 2,369 new recoveries, bringing total to 68,159.
- 30 new mortalities bringing total to 579.
- There are 22,444 active cases, 1,321 of them in critical condition.
- 16,976 PCR tests were conducted, reaching a total of 870,963.
- Ministry of Municipal and Rural Affairs shuts down 32 firms for COVID-19 violations.
- 178,452 expatriates register with the "Awdah" initiative to return to their home countries, only 12,798 departed after their countries accepted to receive them.
- The Red Crescent Authority online training courses related to COVID-19 benefited more than 500,000 individuals across the country, around 240,000 of them in May.
- The "Local Content and Government Procurement Authority" issues a list of medical supplies that is mandatory for suppliers to purchase from domestic manufacturers.
- WHO released two new documents: key planning recommendations for mass gatherings in the context of COVID-19; and, technical guidance for the prevention and control of COVID-19 across long-term care services (see links below).
- WHO lists all candidate COVID-19 vaccines in various stages of development without endorsing any of them (see link below).

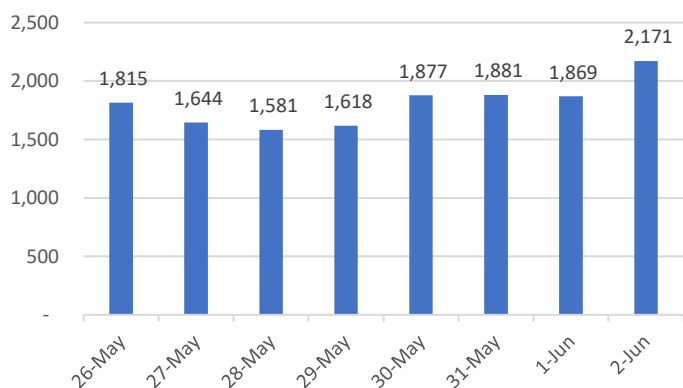

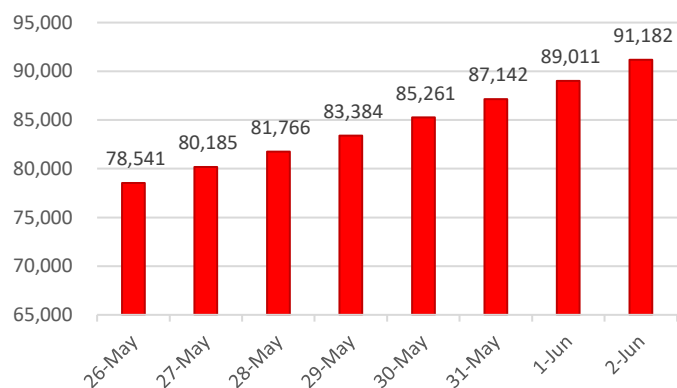
