HIGHLIGHTS

- 7,687 new cases were recorded over the past 3 days, bringing total to 98,869. Of the new cases, 48 % were Saudis, 44% were females and 12% were children.
- 3,632 new recoveries, bringing total to 71,791.
- 97 new mortalities in three days bringing total to 676.
- There are 26,402 active cases, 1,484 of them in critical condition.
- A total of 643 violations of precautionary measures were reported during the first two days in mosques across Saudi Arabia after reopening.
- Over 85,000 Saudi citizens registered to return home residing in 122 countries.
- Curfew in Jeddah from 3 pm until 6 am; mosques will be closed, and cafes/restaurants will provide delivery/take away services only; work attendance in the public sector is suspended while in the private sector from 6 am to 3 pm.
- MoH launches Tataman (تظمن) clinics for COVID-19, more clinics will be added to cover all regions of the Kingdom.
- The Group of 20 (G20) and emerging economies have contributed more than \$21 billion to fight the COVID-19 pandemic.

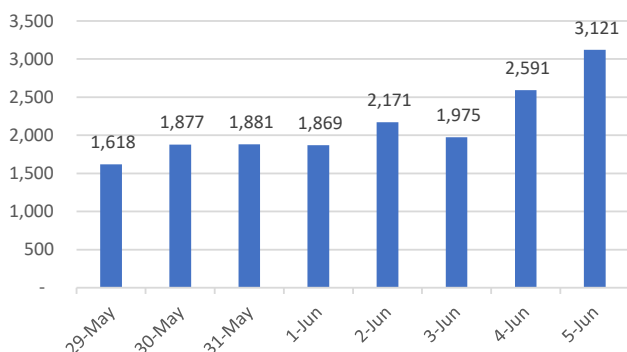

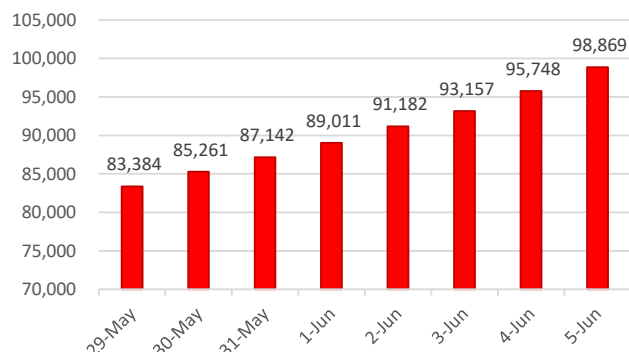
