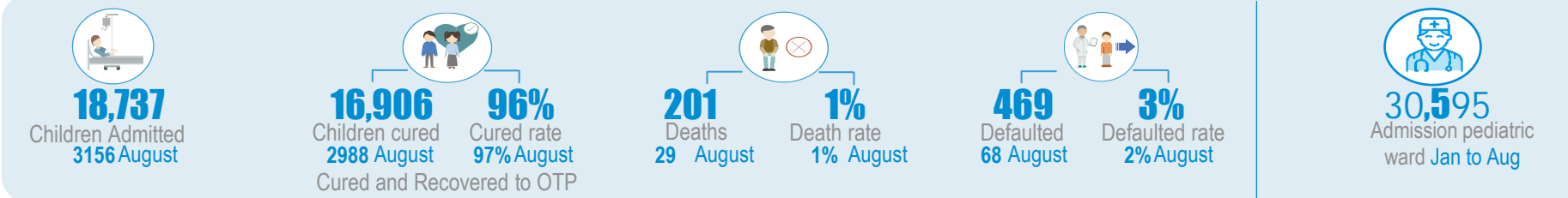

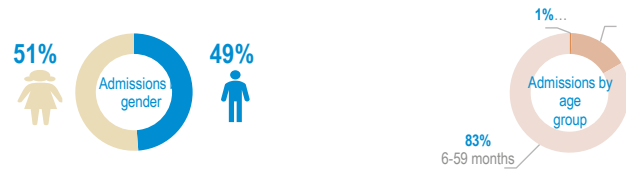
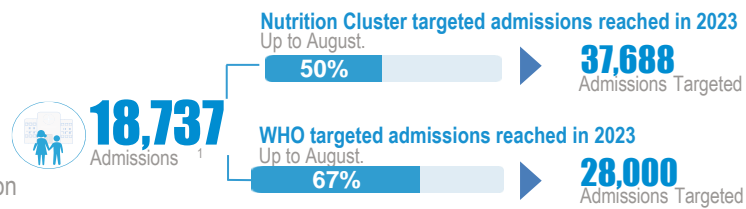


### Service Utilization January-August

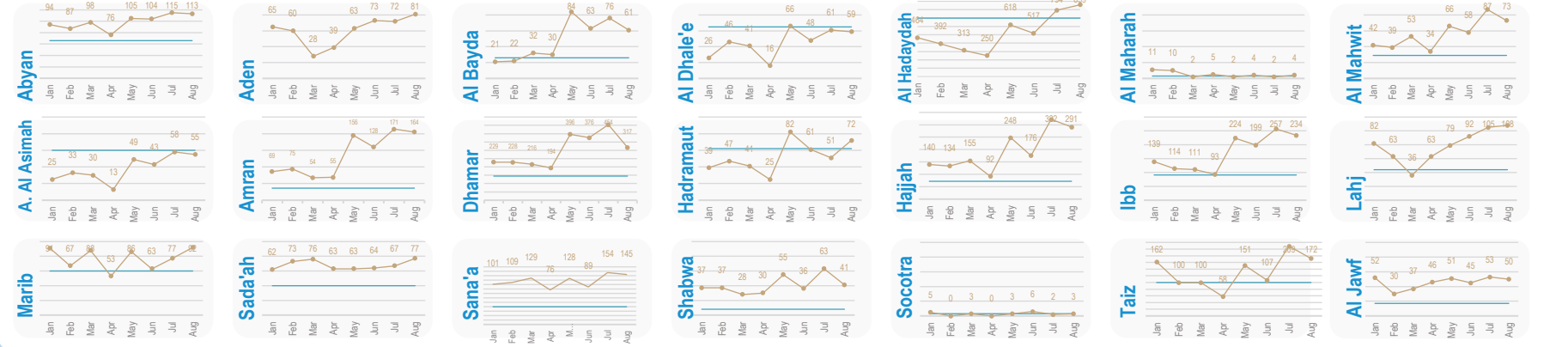
From January to Aug **18,737** children have received life-saving services in WHO-supported TFCs, of which **3,031 (16%)** are children under 6 months.

The quality of service is evidenced by the recovery (**96%**) and death (**1%**) rates. Each caregiver (**18,737**) in total benefits from at least 5 counselling sessions per hospital stay on IYCF best practices. This might contribute to the observed decrease in relapse rate (**2%**) in Aug.

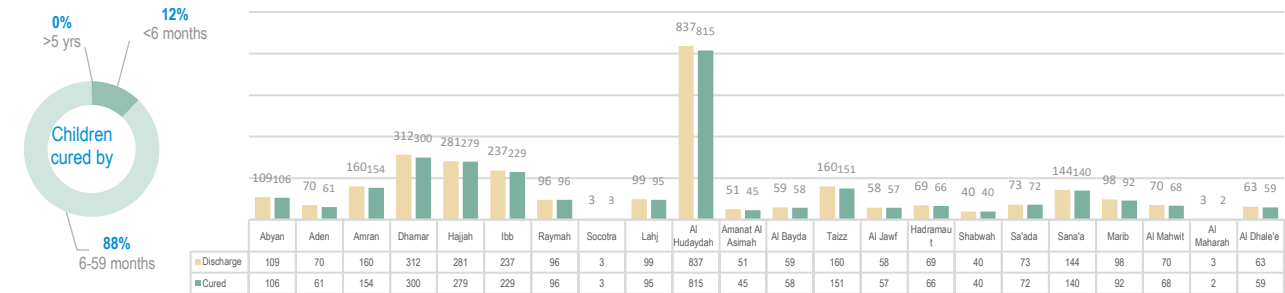
By ensuring the care for most critical cases in pediatric wards in referral hospitals with TFCs, 30,595 children were admitted from Jan to Aug in these referral hospitals for intensive care.



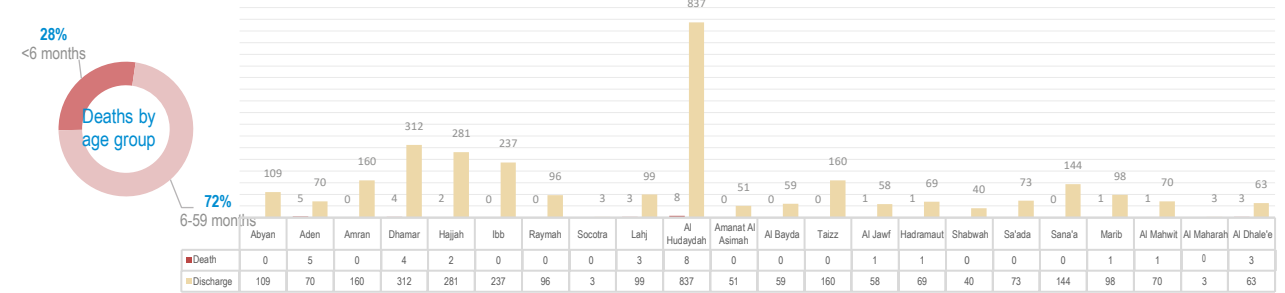
### Service Utilization per Governorate



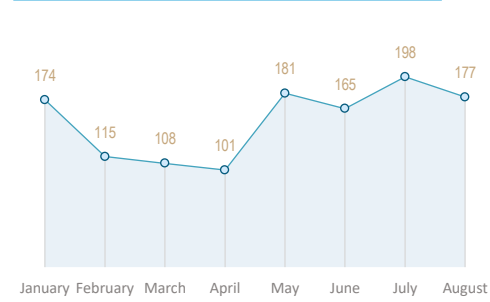
### Cured Children per Governorate August



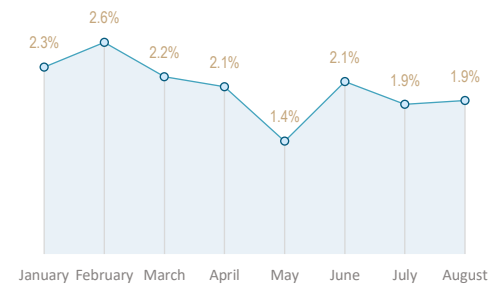
### Deaths per Governorate August



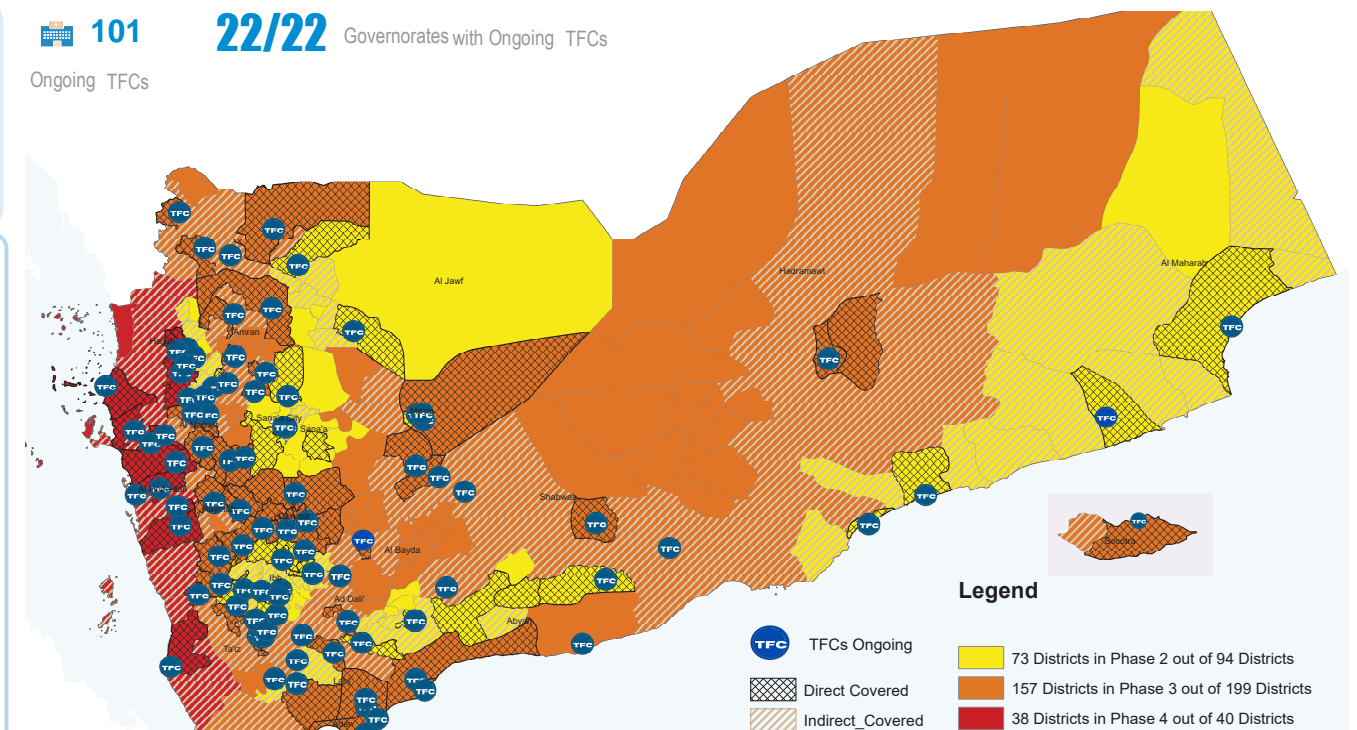

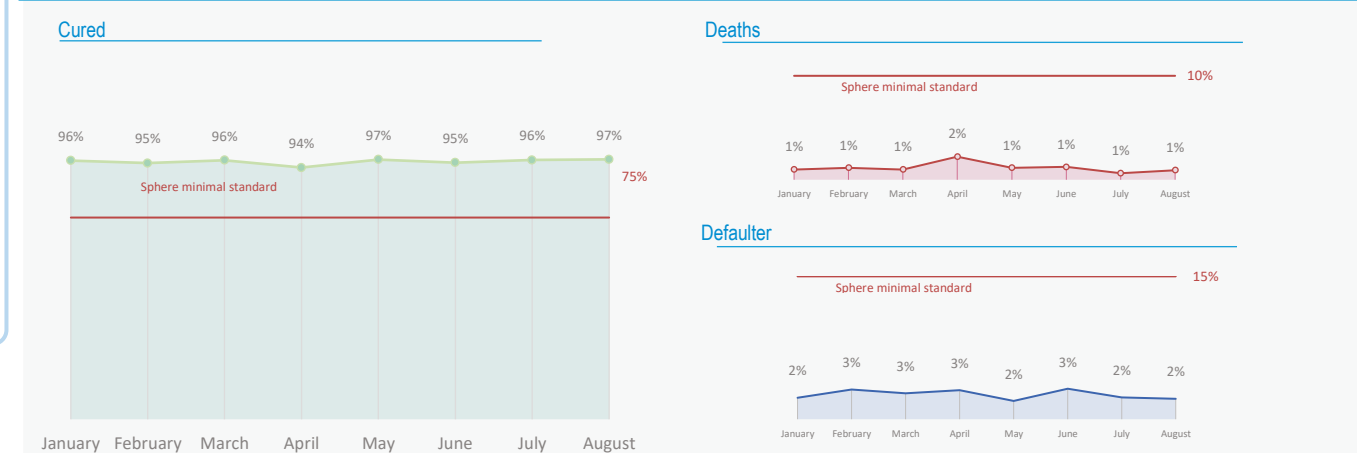
